Accept vs. Except

Accept

Accept (*verb*): to receive something, agree to something, or say yes to something.

I happily **accept** your offer.

Except

Except (*Preposition or conjunction*): not including; everything but; excluding.

Everyone is coming **except** Tom.

HOW TO REMEMBER

Accept = Agree / Receive

Both accept and agree start with **A**

Except = Exclude

Both except and exclude start with **EX**
