Your vs. You're

Your

Your (*possessive adjective*):
shows that something
belongs to the person being
spoken to

Is this **your** cat?

You're

You're (*contraction*): short
for "you are"

I think **you're** going to enjoy
the book.

HOW TO REMEMBER

You're = "you are"

✓ You're late → "You are" late. ✓

✗ Your book → "You are" book. ✗
