## Your vs. You're

### Your

**Your** (*possessive adjective*):  
shows that something  
belongs to the person being  
spoken to

Is this **your** cat?

### You're

**You're** (*contraction*): short  
for "you are"

I think **you're** going to enjoy  
the book.

## HOW TO REMEMBER

**You're** = "you are"

✓ You're late → "You are" late. ✓

✗ Your book → "You are" book. ✗
